# **Aviation Security Training Course 2021**

## Air Cargo and Mail Security\* 22 - 26 March / Please liaise with the ICAO Regional Office

This five-day course is designed to ensure that the relevant personnel can integrate knowledge of Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs) into the context of their designated role in their organization as part of a national responsibility to secure air cargo and mail against acts of unlawful interference, through the application of the relevant competencies and in accordance with Annex 17 and the ICAO Aviation Security Manual (Doc 8973 - Restricted).

#### Crisis Management Workshop 19 - 23 April / USD 650

This five-day workshop is designed to provide management personnel with the knowledge and skills needed to develop and implement sound crisis management procedures. This workshop will provide the personnel at the senior or middle management level of organizations within a State that have been assigned responsibility under that State's National Civil Aviation Security Programme to form part of the crisis management element to respond to acts of unlawful interference occurring within that State.

#### Aviation Security National Inspectors 1-9 June / USD 910

This seven-day course is designed to provide aviation security personnel with theoretical and practical knowledge of audits and inspections as part of a national civil aviation security quality control programme. Participants who successfully complete this course will be prepared to plan, coordinate and conduct quality control measures utilizing Annex 17 and ICAO methodology in accordance with approved programmes.

### Risk Management Workshop 20 -23 July / USD 520

This four day interactive workshop designed for aviation security management personnel, focuses on risk management as it applies to protecting civil aviation against acts of unlawful interference. The workshop will provide participants with the opportunity to assess risk through the identification and evaluation of threats, consequences and vulnerabilities. This workshop will expose participants to guidance material incorporated in the ICAO Global Risk Context Statement and provide the skills necessary to apply risk management methodology when determining the appropriate level of security measures to be implemented. Nominees should be directly involved in the assessment or management of threats, vulnerabilities and/or risk on behalf of their State, to include but not limited to the appropriate authority for aviation security, National Police, Intelligence Services, or, airports, airlines and other aviation security stakeholder.

### Aviation Security National Instructors 31 August - 8 September / USD 910

This seven-day course is designed for personnel involved in the development, management and/or instruction of training materials related to a national civil aviation security training programme. Those who participate in this course will be well versed in the general application of training principles, the preparation of appropriate teaching aids and the tailoring of course material to harmonize course objectives with local and national requirements. It is advisable that nominees have a foundation of AVSEC knowledge and exposure to AVSEC training material prior to attending this course.

## Air Cargo and Mail Security\* 18 - 22 October / Please liaise with the ICAO Regional Office

This five-day course is designed to ensure that the relevant personnel can integrate knowledge of Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs) into the context of their designated role in their organization as part of a national responsibility to secure air cargo and mail against acts of unlawful interference, through the application of the relevant competencies and in accordance with Annex 17 and the ICAO Aviation Security Manual (Doc 8973 - Restricted).

#### Aviation Security Managers Workshop 30 November - 8 December / USD 910

This seven-day workshop is designed to enable participants at the managerial level to plan, coordinate and implement the application of airport security preventive measures in accordance with approved national and airport security programmes. Nominees should have already attended a specialized aviation security training activity, such as the National Civil Aviation Security Programme Workshop, Airport Security Programme Workshop, and/or airport security regulatory experience prior to attending this training event. Standards and Recommended Practices from the Annex 17 – Security, as well as the ICAO Aviation Security Manual (Doc 8973 – Restricted) will be frequently referred to during the training event.
